The meeting began at 5:34 PM.

### 1. SLMPD Report

The SLMPD crime map showing incidents for the January in Skinker DeBaliviere and the immediate area was shared on screen with the various reported crime descriptions highlighted. The map showed a very low number of incidents in the neighborhood. Copy of this map and the December crime stats are included in these minutes.

Captain McCloskey provided an update on the officer-involved shooting that occurred the previous night (February 2) in the 5700 block of Waterman. He emphasized that the incident was isolated and involved parties who knew each other, with the suspect using violence against both a female victim and an officer. Captain McCloskey praised the officers' heroic response and confirmed that the Force Investigative Unit would handle the investigation. He noted that while the female victim had passed away, all officers involved were safe, though some would be off work temporarily, and other officers had volunteered to work overtime to support their colleagues and the community.

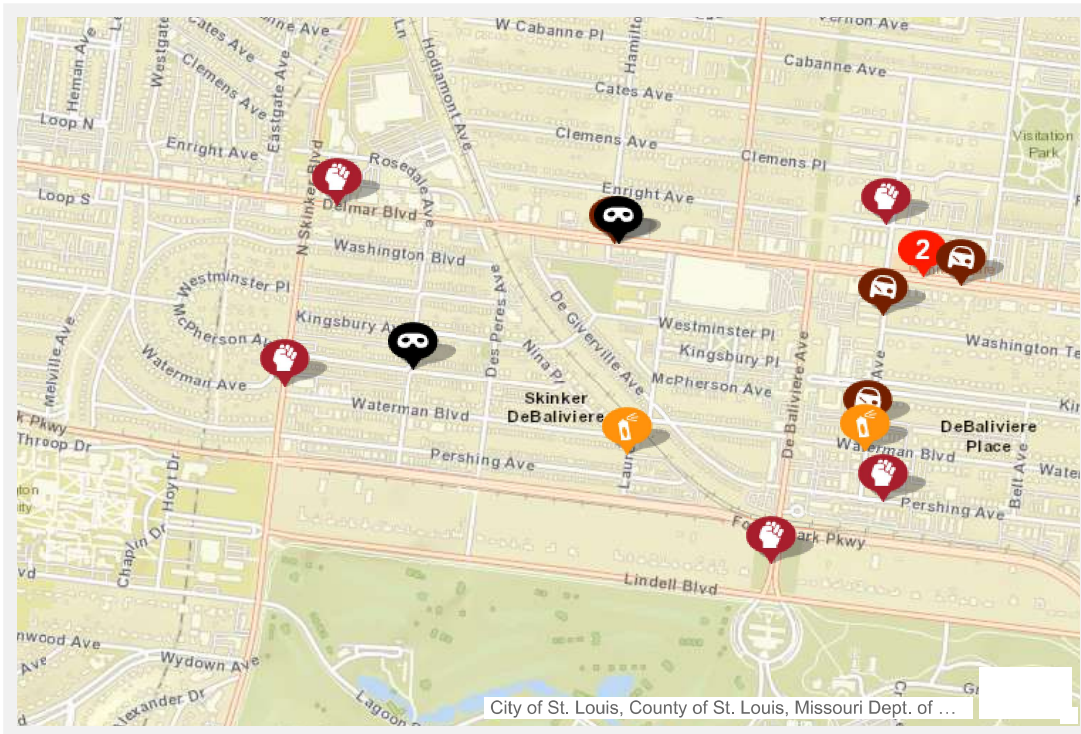

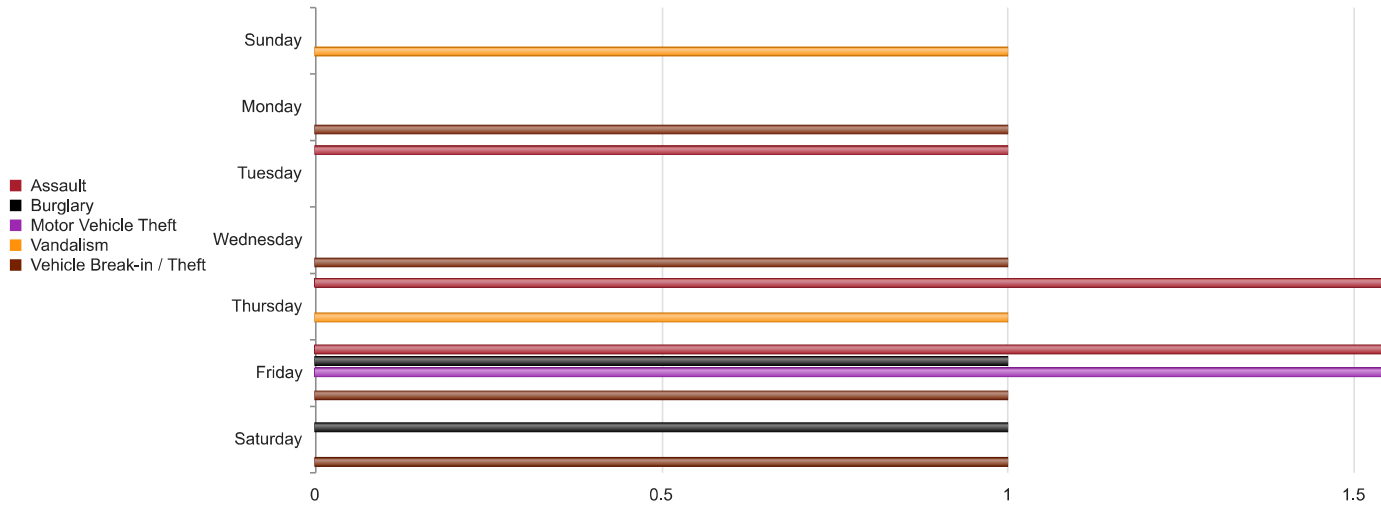

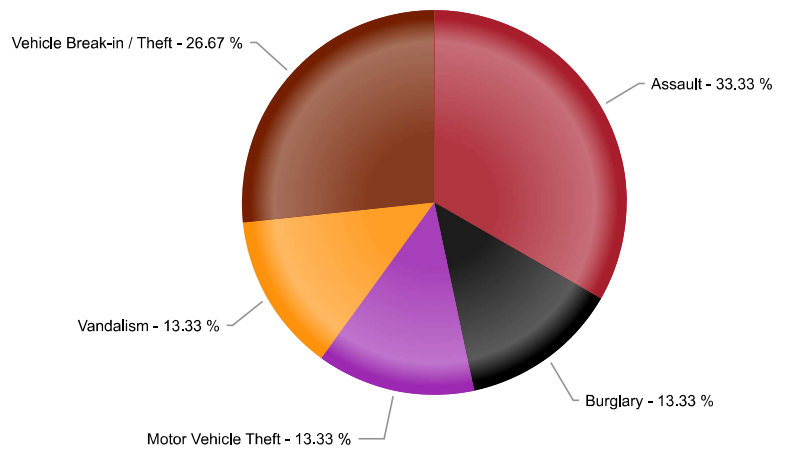
